

DUKE TIP 2009-2010

Duke TIP letters of eligibility have been sent to qualifying seventh grade Martin students as of this week (August 31-Sept. 4). If you receive a letter, please note the highlighted areas. In particular, please note Section 9: Qualifying Scores. For Wake County students, you do not need to provide a percentile score; you only need to write in “Wake County qualified” in the appropriate area. If you are applying online, there are specific directions for Wake County students to enter qualifying scores. Please refer to the letter for these directions.

Also included in the letter is information about both the SAT and ACT. Neither Duke TIP nor Martin recommends one test over the other; the choice is up to you and your child.

Students are eligible for Duke TIP by scoring a 95% or higher on a standardized assessment (like the EOG) in either grades 5 or 6. If your child did not receive a Duke TIP letter of eligibility and you feel he/she should have, please call or email me (919-571-6958; kwagoner@wcpss.net).
